

## **Day-01** ARRIVAL IN MANALI | SIGHTSEEING


- Arrive in Manali in the morning and check in to the hotel.

- Return to the hotel by evening and enjoy a restful sleep.




- Wake up early, have breakfast, and check out.



# CANCELATION

- ✓ Free Cancellation up to 60 days before the departure date (Booking amount is non-refundable)
- ✓ If you're canceling the trip and opting for a refund within 59 days to 45 days of the departure date, then only 10% of the total trip cost (calculated after subtracting the booking amount), along with the booking amount (non-refundable), will be charged as a cancellation fee, and the remaining sum will be refunded.
- ✓ If you're canceling the trip and opting for a refund within 44 days to 30 days of the departure date, then 25% of the total trip cost (calculated after subtracting the booking amount), along with the booking amount (nonrefundable), will be charged as a cancellation fee, and the remaining sum will be refunded.
- ✓ If you're canceling the trip and opting for a refund within 29 days to 15 days of the departure date, then 50% of the total trip cost (calculated after subtracting the booking amount), along with the booking amount (non-refundable), will be charged as a cancellation fee, and the remaining sum will be refunded.
- ✓ If you're canceling the trip and opting for a refund within 15 days to 8 days of the departure date, then 75% of the total trip cost (calculated after subtracting the booking amount), along with the booking amount (non-refundable), will be charged as a cancellation fee, and the remaining sum will be refunded.





- ✓ If you're canceling the trip and opting for a refund within 7 days of the departure date, then 100% of the total trip cost (calculated after subtracting the booking amount), along with the booking amount (non-refundable), will be charged as a cancellation fee, and the remaining sum will be refunded. You are not eligible for a refund if you fail to show up on the day of departure within the given timeline provided to you beforehand.
