






BEAUTY OF Himachal Bradesh

ARRIVAL IN MANALI | JOGINI FALLS | OVERNIGHT STAY AT MANALI

- Head for local sightseeing: Visit Hadimba Devi Temple, an ancient wooden temple surrounded by Deodar trees, trek to the beautiful Jogini Waterfalls, and explore the lively Old Manali cafés.
- Spend the evening exploring Mall Road & Tibetan Market.
- In the evening, return back to the hotel for overnight stay.

MANALI | SOLANG VALLEY | LAHAUL VALLEY VIA ATAL TUNNEL | SISSU | **OVERNIGHT STAY AT KASOL**

- Enjoy an overnight stay in camps at Kasol.

- Begin your journey to Jibhi, passing through the scenic route of Banjar Valley, surrounded by lush forests, before arriving at your destination.
- Upon reaching Jibhi, check in to the hotel and take some rest. Nestled in the Kullu district of Himachal Pradesh, Jibhi is a charming village surrounded by breathtaking natural beauty, offering a taste of an offbeat destination.
- As you arrive in Jibhi, a favorite destination for backpackers, you can try trout fishing and explore the surroundings. Enjoy an overnight stay at your hotel in Jibhi.



HIKE TO SEROLSAR LAKE | JALORI PASS | DEPARTURE TO DELHI

- Trek back to Jalori Pass and then return to Jibhi.
