



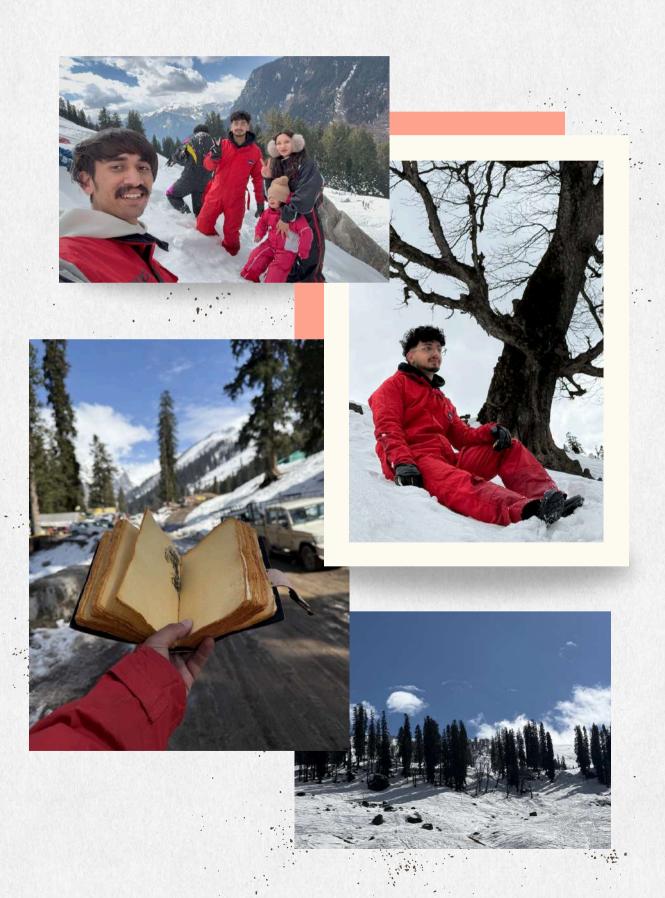
ABOUT the place
