

- Enjoy a comfortable overnight journey with scenic highway views.






Arrival in Sangla . Stay at Sangla

- Visit the historic Tabo Monastery, also known as the "Ajanta of the Himalayas."


If you're canceling the trip and opting for a refund within 29 days to 15 days of the departure date, then 50% of the total trip cost (calculated after subtracting the booking amount), along with the booking amount (nonrefundable), will be charged as a cancellation fee, and the remaining sum will be refunded.

If you're canceling the trip and opting for a refund within 15 days to 8 days of the departure date, then 75% of the total trip cost (calculated after subtracting the booking amount), along with the booking amount (nonrefundable), will be charged as a cancellation fee, and the remaining sum will be refunded.
