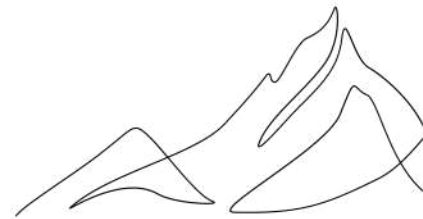

Day- 01



Delhi to Shimla (Overnight Volvo)

- Board your evening semi-sleeper Volvo from Delhi (Kashmiri Gate ISBT) between 8 PM–10 PM.
- Overnight journey to Shimla. Approx travel time: 8–9 hours.



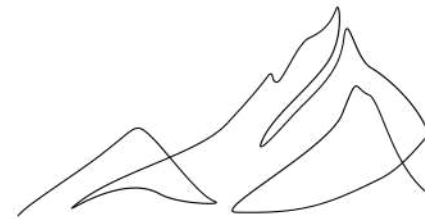
Day- 02

Arrive Shimla – Narkanda – Rampur – Sangla
(Meals: Dinner)

- Meet your group captain and fellow travelers in Shimla.
- Board the tempo traveler and begin your scenic ride.
- En route, visit Narkanda, Rampur Bushahr, Bhaba Nagar, and Karcham Dam.
- Reach Sangla by evening. Check in, relax and enjoy the first Himalayan night.
- Overnight Stay: Sangla



Day- 03



Sangla – Chitkul – Kalpa (Meals: Breakfast & Dinner)

- After breakfast, visit Chitkul – the last Indian village near the China border.
- Enjoy time by the Baspa River.
- Head to Kalpa, check in, and visit:
 - Roghi Cliff Point
 - Chinni Village
 - Local Market
- Overnight Stay: Kalpa



Day- 04



Kalpa – Khab – Nako – Gue – Tabo
(Meals: Breakfast & Dinner)

- View Kinner Kailash from your hotel.
- Drive to Tabo via:
 - Khab bridge (confluence point)
 - Nako Lake & Monastery
 - Gue Village (Buddhist Mummy Monastery)
- Explore Tabo Monastery & Tabo Caves.
- Overnight Stay: Tabo



Day- 05



Tabo – Dhankar – Pin Valley (Mud) – Kaza
(Meals: Breakfast & Dinner)

- Visit Dhankar Monastery (cliff-top architecture)
- Explore Pin Valley National Park and Mud Village
- Cross Sagnam Village, a hidden gem in Spiti.
- Reach Kaza by evening.
- Overnight Stay: Kaza

Kaza – Langza – Hikkim – Komic – Kaza
(Meals: Breakfast & Dinner)

- ▶ Full-day local tour:
 - Langza – Fossil Village
 - Hikkim – World’s highest post office
 - Komic – World’s highest motorable village
- ▶ Overnight Stay: Kaza



Day- 07

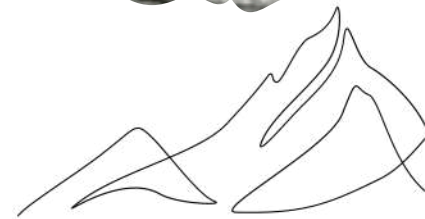


Kaza – Ki Monastery – Kibber – Chicham – Kunzum – Chandratal
(Meals: Breakfast & Dinner)

- Visit Key Monastery and Kibber Village
- Drive over Chicham Bridge (Asia's highest)

- Walk near the lake (camping is 2 km below as per forest rules)
- Overnight Stay: Campsite near Chandratal

Chandratal – Atal Tunnel – Solang – Manali – Delhi (Volvo)

- Wake early and visit Chandratal Lake
- Drive to Manali via Atal Tunnel and Solang Valley
- Reach Manali by evening and board your Volvo back to Delhi

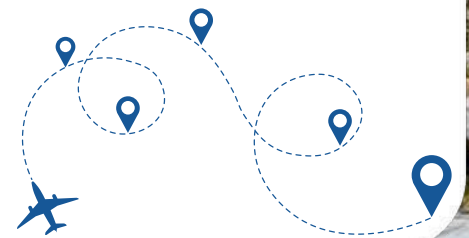

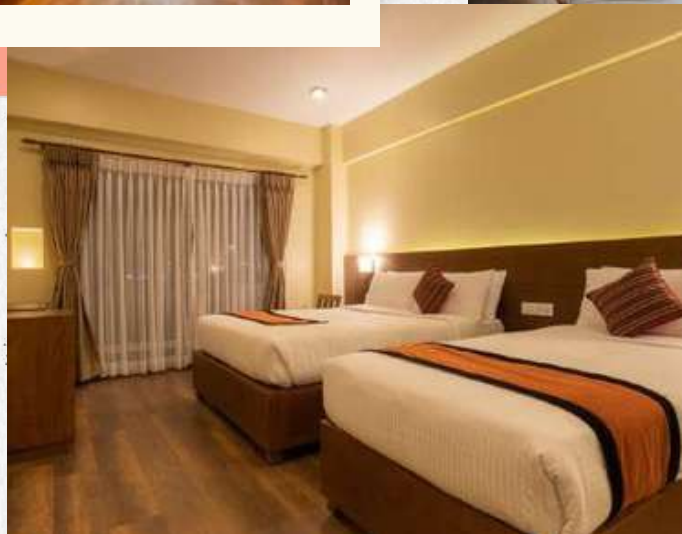

CANCELLATION *Policy*

- Free Cancellation up to 60 days before the departure date (Booking amount is non-refundable)
- If you're canceling the trip and opting for a refund within 59 days to 45 days of the departure date, then only 10% of the total trip cost (calculated after subtracting the booking amount), along with the booking amount (non-refundable), will be charged as a cancellation fee, and the remaining sum will be refunded.
- If you're canceling the trip and opting for a refund within 44 days to 30 days of the departure date, then 25% of the total trip cost (calculated after subtracting the booking amount), along with the booking amount (non-refundable), will be charged as a cancellation fee, and the remaining sum will be refunded.
- If you're canceling the trip and opting for a refund within 29 days to 15 days of the departure date, then 50% of the total trip cost (calculated after subtracting the booking amount), along with the booking amount (non-refundable), will be charged as a cancellation fee, and the remaining sum will be refunded.
- If you're canceling the trip and opting for a refund within 15 days to 8 days of the departure date, then 75% of the total trip cost (calculated after subtracting the booking amount), along with the booking amount (non-refundable), will be charged as a cancellation fee, and the remaining sum will be refunded.



- If you're canceling the trip and opting for a refund within 7 days of the departure date, then 100% of the total trip cost (calculated after subtracting the booking amount), along with the booking amount (non-refundable), will be charged as a cancellation fee, and the remaining sum will be refunded. You are not eligible for a refund if you fail to show up on the day of departure within the given timeline provided to you beforehand.
- No refund will be provided in case of issues arising due to government orders, harsh weather conditions, protests, landslides, or any other unforeseen circumstances. In such situations, we usually have a backup plan ready and will proceed accordingly.
- There may be times when we have to cancel certain activities mentioned in the itinerary, but only due to circumstances beyond our control.
- If a trek / trip is called off at the last moment due to a natural calamity or unforeseen circumstances (such as rain, snowfall, earthquake, landslides, strike, or bandh), participants will be provided with a travel voucher of the same amount. This voucher can be used within 365 days from the date of issuance for any package of equal value.
- If a trek or trip has to be aborted midway due to a natural calamity or unforeseen circumstances (such as rain, snowfall, earthquake, landslides, strike, or bandh), no refund will be provided.
- Travel Coffee will not cover any additional expenses incurred due to natural calamities or unforeseen circumstances (such as rain, snowfall, earthquakes, landslides, strikes, or bandhs).
